

CERTIFICATE OF ART IN LEADERSHIP

The specialty of Leadership is an undergraduate degree program of 30 credits per hour designed for students who desire to grow in their new identity in Christ, discover their call and destiny, and lead others towards a life of purpose. Below is the proposed study sequence.

SCHEDULE AND REGISTRATION DEADLINE

- The time commitment required to complete the entire course schedule is approximately 10 months (12 hours of monthly class attendance and 5 hours minimum of monthly self study.)
- Registration deadline is two weeks prior to the first class attended.
- Specific information regarding certificate and degree programs is available upon request.
- Registration fee: \$30 per student for I year program.
- Tuition per student for entire 1 year program (consisting of 10 courses) is \$1,250
- Monthly payment plan available: Payment due at the beginning of each course attended. Each course is \$125
- Degree seeking students are required to purchase all class materials, fulfill all required hours, and complete all assignments (other requirements may apply).
